All plants will come in quart size pots (Approx.. 2.75" x 3 .25") Plants will vary in size between 2 and 12 inches.

This year we have chosen more species for you to try as well as can guarantee the plants to be larger in size and hopefully better quality. *For those of you interested in Sweet Grass please note that it will not be “bushy”/large as seen at our local Pow Wow’s. They would be considered a single starter plant.*

Planting Native Plants

Native plants are extremely temperamental and require extra care compared to domestic plants or annual garden plants. When choosing a planting site, consider weather, soil moisture, soil type, and the amount of sunlight the plant needs. When transplanting the plants from their pot to the prepared site consider the weather and timing of transplant. CLMCD can provide transplanting instructions, but be sure to read about the delicate nature of native plants using various online resources available. Remember native plants can take three or more years to establish in perfect conditions.
