## Position Posted: Invasive Species Field Technician

**Four (4) Month Seasonal/Temporary Position**

### General Description:

The Chippewa Luce Mackinac Conservation District is seeking interested applicants to serve as an Invasive Species Field Technician for the Three Shores Cooperative Invasive Species Management Area. This is a seasonal/temporary position averaging 40 hours per week from May 14 – August 2018. Work schedule will average 5 days per week including some weekends. Duties will be comprised of field work including but not limited to invasive plant control either manually, chemically, or mechanically on land and in water, proper data collection, daily survey/mapping/monitoring data entry, and attend outreach events as needed. Employee will be required to become a Michigan certified pesticide applicator & apply herbicide when applicable. Employee will be supervised by the Invasive Species Program Coordinator and an Invasive Species Crew Lead.
