#### 2024 Flower Garden Kits

These economical kits include 38 2 x 5 inch plugs that cover 38 square feet at 1 foot spacing; or up to 57 square feet at 1.5 sq. ft. spacing. Comes with an information sheet. Each plant is individually tagged for identification and all tags include plant height and requirements, so you can alter the layout to suit your space.

Yooper Sunshine Garden Kit	A good variety of plants that are Yooper-tough from all UP seed. This mix of plants will provide flowers, food, and habitat for a variety of beneficial local insects, pollinators, and birds.	\$100/kit
Butterfly Garden Kit  This kit contains as many host plants for as many UP butterflies as we could identify and include. It also contains a colorful variety of nectar plants that will signal the presence of butterfly-friendly habitat to adults and other pollinators. Rain Garden Garden Kit	You have probably heard about rain gardens. Rain gardens are plantings in constructed or natural low areas that collect excess water and allow it to soak into the ground rather than running into storm drains or water-logging other areas. Rain gardens can help recharge groundwater levels, filter pollution, and prevent erosion, all while adding beauty and helping bees, butterflies, birds, and other wildlife. A rain garden can turn a problem area into a landscape point-of-pride.	\$100/kit
Wild Bird Garden Kit	Seeds, nest material, hummingbird nectar, and shelter for UP birds. Based on Audubon native plant recommendations for UP birds. Features seeds for several different types of feeding styles, from grosbeaks to finches. Also includes host plants for the insects needed to feed hungry nestlings. Native grasses like bluestem form sturdy clumps that hold seeds above the snow for winter feeding, habitat for larvae for nestlings, and offer shelter for ground birds like grouse. Birds such as Orioles favor stripping the bark from milkweeds for nesting material, while studies have shown that nests incorporating Yarrow deter parasitic insects.	\$100/kit
